Annual Plan

We have been developing specific advisories that are shared between SCC & SLSD and this has been going quite well. We are expanding this to include:

- Engineering & Robotics: We are adding this year
- Health Sciences (focused on Biotechnology) is in the works

These current Dual Credit Agreements between SCC & SLSD provide an avenue for students to earn college credits while taking high school courses.

- Business & Marketing
- Biotechnology
- Anatomy & Physiology
- Automotive

We are also starting the conversation around including the Graphic Design & Digital Photography classes.

Program Evaluations:

- Dan has completed the CTE program evaluations for the 2021-2022 school year.
- All program areas met the OSPI standards this year.

Career Navigation and Student Transition Program:

SCC & SLSD are piloting a Career Navigation and Student Transition program designed to encourage students to explore the educational and funding opportunities that are accessible for them to attend college and earn a degree.

We have designated some of our Perkins funds to help cover the salary expense this year. Our plan is to double the number of hours and funding to target additional students.

Committee approved the 2022-2023 multi-year Annual Plan and the use of Perkins funds

Follow-up from December Meeting – High School Outreach

Freddy Varga, Inez Olive, Katie Rouso presented the SCC-SLSD Career Navigation and Student Transition program where we could provide:

- Career Exploration
- Applying for Admission
- Applying for funding
- Field trip

This year was directed towards the multi-language learners and will expand to other cohorts in the future.

We brought 70 students to the SCC and toured the campus. The students were able to meet the professional technical navigators and get a look at all of the programs that are available for them here. The amount of interest and excitement generated was terrific.

We'll use the summer to plan out next steps for the following year, such as

- How to market this program to the students, helping them to understand that these programs are available for them.
- How to bring awareness to the importance about the technical programs that exist at the college.

- Bringing awareness to parents of these programs so that they can encourage their students to utilize the programs.
