Reauthorizing of the vulnerable Worker Status eligibility criteria.

The State Board of Community and Technical colleges require us to get the yearly approval of the Worker Retraining Advisory board regarding the use of the Vulnerable Worker Status eligibility criteria. To meet this eligibility criteria, one must meet two of the following three reasons.

If a person's previous occupation is in decline.
If a person has no degree and /or less than 45 College credits.
To remain employed, if a person needs to obtain skills upgrade.
