Program Update and Status Report (Rosie)

Discussion about the current plans to demolish Building 2500 and clinic by July 1, 2020 and the impact on the dental hygiene program

Letter by Dr. Kintner was read aloud to all

Shoreline Dental Hygiene is a “gold standard” for dental hygiene education

Cost of building needs to be reviewed and discussed

Alternative locations on campus are being discussed, #1300

Off campus locations are being explored (Prosser Building on Aurora)

Community partners are being sought

There is a minimum obligation to current students

Accreditation standards require at minimum a “teach out plan” (VP King)

Clinic is needed to continue dental hygiene education without interruption

Status of Bachelor program needs to continue without interruption – next deadline May 2020

To determine the programs going into the newly planned building, metrics such as vitality of the program and potential for growth are considered (VP King)

Identified associations and legislators to contact: dental hygiene association and dental association

Budget to relocate was estimated and options to relocate were discussed (UW, Sand Point?)

Options for college to change building plans were discussed

Condition of current building to operate ~5+ years in current location was discussed

Action: VP King to explore options with #1300 building – will get back with results in 1 month

Items to discuss at next emergency meeting:

2. Positive decision on location of the dental hygiene program
