Welcome and Introductions

- Bob Biesiedzinski opened the meeting and all present introduced themselves.

Approval of Minutes

- Copies of minutes from the November 15, 2016 meeting were passed out and were approved as written.

State of the Program

- Current on-campus class has 10 students enrolled
- Current internship class has 11 students enrolled
 - 3 students will be graduating at the end of spring quarter
 - 12 students total will be graduating in the 12/16-12/17 time frame
- Summer quarter 2017 enrollment is way down
 - 8 students are currently enrolled
 - A request for the service managers to look at their current employees for potential students to fill the vacant seats
- Fall 2017 class is fully enrolled with 13 students

Promotional Opportunities

- High school field trips are scheduled for two area high school automotive programs
 - Marysville-Pilchuck HS on Thursday, May 11th
 - Cascade High School on Tuesday, June 6th
- Bob is continuing to visit area high school automotive programs to promote the PACT Program

Best Utilization of your PACT Student

- PACT Students spend approximately \$15,000 to complete the program
- PACT Students are trained using current technology
- PACT Students are trained on current model Honda and Acura vehicles
- PACT Students are taught all NATEF required tasks
- PACT Students are your future workforce at your dealership
- PACT Students need to be growing as technicians by being allowed to work on more than just the ExpressService jobs

NATEF Re-certification

- Onsite re-certification is completed every 5 years
- There is a mid-point self-evaluation completed at the 2 ½ year point

- The members of the committee were provided with access to the Honda PACT NATEF documentation, laptop computers and NATEF Evaluation Worksheets
- The members of the committee reviewed all provided information, conducted on-sight inspections and scored each of the areas of certification on a 1-5 scale with 5 being the highest possible score
