II. Approval of January 19, 2016 Minutes

III. Member Updates

Kathryn Ogden – Swedish Medical Center

- No new announcements
- Ballard taking new practicum students – they cannot take clinical groups
- Next residency program (mother/baby) in June
- Psych units just opened at Ballard. Will ask in Fall for clinical group placement – maybe a split with med/surg and psych – something with addiction unit?

Becky Alderson/Kelsey Hughes

- Updates – main focus right now on graduation
- Looking to have a summer event for all students including new 1st Quarter and 10 Quarter students – maybe a BBQ
- Losing a lot of the current SCCANS leadership
- Very organized at this point/binder will be passed over on Thursday
- Graduation – next Thursday, June 9th

Anna Sterner

- Faculty presented poster at QSEN Conference last week in San Antonio, TX
- 4 people worked on project – Anna Sterner, Lori Stephens, Corki Budnick and Betty Kost- used 10 Essentials format with 7 competencies; handout provided to Advisory Committee members
- Thanks given to Lynn and Cathy for their support on this project
- June retreat to move on to next step in establishing the QSEN competencies
- Lynn will be presenting on curriculum revisions for opening week

Karen Paulsen – Northwest Hospital

- Very busy
- Doing lots of hiring
- Residency open house just took place – more new residents than before
- Changing policy about attending new preceptor course
- 102 preceptors currently in hospital – looking to have 80% participation in next training opportunity
- Getting ready to have rehabilitation unit open for fall. Not big enough for 8 students but some students could rotate off unit. Nursing units are asking clinical groups to go down to 6 students.
- Huge issue with Childbirth Center not having enough patients. Using role playing and simulation to fill the gap. Preparing a notebook to establish alternatives for learning when patient census is low.
 - Kathryn - Swedish could take 10 students in post-partum, anti-partum
 - Mary and Jess will look in to this
- Mentoring students – Staff want to be paid for this
- NWH is doing more peer interviewing
 - Have SCCANS group schedule Brown Bag on how to peer interview
 - Peer interviewers complete a peer interviewing class
 - Looking at all applicants including ADNs

Mary Burroughs/Jess Simpson

- Now have an OADN Honor Society – Alpha Delta Nu
 - Requirements – 3.0 in pre-requisites and Nursing courses; made eligible in 4th quarter, complete a teaching presentation in 5th quarter and if GPA maintained, they are inducted at graduation
 - The first 6 members will be inducted at graduation in June
 - At this time there is 26 provisional members
- 48 students in Health Promotions – big thank you to Kathryn for placements for Health Promotion students

Trena Redman

- Thank you to Kathryn for placement of 4th quarter students at Swedish Issaquah

- Trena went to Master Trainer TEAMStepps program in February – completed a project on how to implement TEAMStepps across the curriculum
- 4th Quarter will be implementing QSEN this Fall (2016)
- More discussion at syllabus retreat in June
- NWH and Swedish use TEAMStepps concepts
- TEAMStepps in long term care program – Anna Sterner will send information to 1st Quarter faculty

- Implementing TEAMStepps

Anna Shanks

- No placement at Harborview for next year –
 - Lynn has sent an email and made a phone call to determine the reason why no placement
- 10 quarter students will be going to Fairfax this summer quarter

Lori Stephens

- Electronic record, NeehrPerfect, being implemented in 3rd quarter– best used after lab is over
- Tomorrow Sim and Skills lab will be taking place for 3rd quarter
- Lori will have a new f/t teaching partner starting in Fall 2016
- Going to QSEN was a great learning experience – how to document near misses? Scenarios would be created for students to notice misses

Betty Kost

- QSEN – how to communicate with students using QSEN principles.
- Bar code readers and PYXIS will get updated this summer

Corki Budnick

- Corki will be writing up some “pearls” to send out to all faculty

Catherine Otto

- We won’t hear about budget until the end of next week
- Submitted four requests for staff changes
- Pro-rata position has been approved for the year to cover Anna’s sabbatical next Spring

IV. Shoreline Nursing Program Updates

- **NCLEX results-** 76.92% one semi-annual report; 24 took the test and 19 passed
 - Lynn has worked with all 5 students who failed- four have passed on second time
- **Employment Summaries**

- Lynn finds this useful
- Kathryn and Karen will take this back to their HR departments to see if this is useful/helpful
- A recommendation will be made at the Faculty Retreat in September
- **Consortium Survey**
