### **Student Progress Updates**

- T-TEN Professional Certification Technicians
  - 12 Technicians in 2017
  - Should we do it again?
    - Yes and 6 Technicians were immediately identified, with other candidates to consider
- Graduating Class (2017 Cohort)
  - 8 Students from 7 different dealerships
  - This Cohort accumulated 47 ASE Certifications in total 3 of which are L1
- Sophomore Class (2018 Cohort)
  - 12 Students from 8 different dealerships
  - These 12 Students have accumulated 48 ASE Certifications in total
  - On track to graduate in August, 2018
- Freshman Class (2019 Cohort)
  - 18 Students from 13 different dealerships

### **T-TEN Student Recruitment**

- Outreach in high schools in the area
  - Recruiting Presentation → Gather Leads → Contact and Qualify Leads → Job Shadows at your Dealerships → Employment → Dealerships Select Students
- Incentives / Scholarships
  - Dealerships can send tax-deductible donation to the College Foundation and give specific parameters on how the dealership wants the money spent, such as Student, tools, tuition, fuel expenses, etc.
